Partnership Awards

recognize outstanding Coastal America partnership efforts and/or multi-agency projects.

Spirit Awards

recognize outstanding partnership efforts that demonstrate the "spirit" of Coastal America.

Criteria:

- At least one (1) federal agency partner, as well as one (1) non-federal entity must be involved in the project.
- The project must clearly demonstrate the "value-added" of the partnership effort.
- The project should demonstrate an innovative or unique way of accomplishing stated goals and objectives with positive environmental results.
- The project must demonstrate a contribution to the Coastal America objectives: (1) to protect, preserve and restore the Nation's coastal resources; and/or (2) to increase public awareness and education.

Nominations:

Nominations should be submitted using the nomination form available on Coastal America's website (www.coastalamerica.gov/text/awards.html) or by submitting a written nomination (3 pages maximum, 12 point font, single spaced) addressing the following questions.



Tim Keeney, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Oceans and Atmosphere, Commerce, presented a Partnership Award to the Aquatic Invasives Tool Kit Team.

1. What is the name of the nominated team?
2. Identify the team leader, team members, and their agency affiliation. Provide all contact information, including mail, phone, fax and email addresses.
3. How did the team demonstrate the "value added" of a partnership effort? (e.g., how did the project or process accomplish what a single agency alone could not?)
4. Describe the project or process you are nominating and how it is creative or innovative.
5. What are the most significant achievements and outcomes of the project or process?
6. Explain how the project or process contributes to Coastal America's mission to protect, preserve, and restore coastal resources.
7. Has the project been endorsed by a Coastal America regional team?
8. Nominator should provide name, contact information, and date of nomination.

Special Recognition Awards

recognize non-federal organizations for their demonstrated leadership in establishing partnerships.

Criteria:

- A non-federal organization must have made a significant or innovative contribution to coastal restoration, preservation, protection, and/or to increase public awareness and education. The organization may be a member of a nominated partnership or spirit award team.

Nominations:

Nominations should be submitted using the nomination form available on Coastal America's website (www.coastalamerica.gov/text/awards.html) or by submitting a written nomination (2 pages maximum, 12 point font, single spaced) addressing the following.

1. What is the name of the nominated organization?
2. Explain how the organization demonstrated leadership in establishing partnerships.
3. Describe how the organization's leadership efforts contribute to Coastal America's mission to protect, preserve, and restore coastal resources.
4. Nominator should include name, contact information, and date of nomination.
